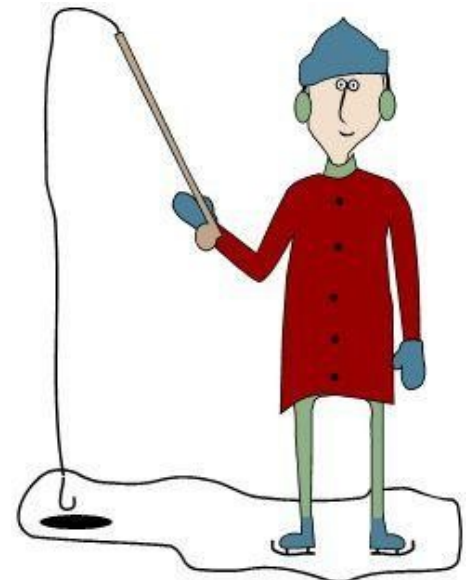
"Biggest Sucka" Competiton

- Tax-deductible bribes (a.k.a. cookies, goodies, and other assorted buy-offs) will be accepted by the Official Derby Judges. You must sneak up to the Official Derby Tent during Derby Hours for a covert hand-off.
- Suckers must be caught during the Derby Hours. No cheating! The "big sucka" will be announced on Sunday at 2:30 pm.
